## Toss the Ball – You’re it!!

**Supplies Needed:** Soft rubber ball that can be tossed from person to person.

### Instructions:

Remind the group of the Take Home Assignment from Session 1. They were to interview entrepreneurs in their local area and be prepared to report back what they learned at this session. Start out by tossing the ball to someone in the group. In two minutes or less, the person holding the ball should report on the following:

1. Identify the entrepreneur they interviewed . .
  - a. Name of entrepreneur
  - b. Name of business
  - c. Location of business – town, rural etc.
  - d. Type of business
2. Tell the group one item they gleaned from the interview that they didn’t know previously such as . . . .
  - a. Product or services rendered
  - b. Distribution of Product or service such as globally, internet etc.
3. Describe one characteristic of entrepreneur from interview.
4. Anything else they would like to share from their interview.

Person holding the ball then tosses it to another person – not the person sitting right beside them. The ball should be tossed around the room at random. The next person holding the ball reports in. Game continues until all have reported – or until you run out of time dedicated for this activity.
