



Discussion Questions for Action Plan Exercise:*

1. Task Definition

- What do I still need to learn about my action item?
- What information should I gather for my action item?
- What is my task in this project?

2. Identify Information Sources

- What other reliable information sources should I investigate and use?
- Are there some local experts who I can Interview to learn more about my topic and It's impact to my community?

3. Location and Access

- Where do I locate credible sources?
- Can I find more information in my local library?
- Who could help me with online catalogs, reference sections or government documents?

4. Use of Information

- What question does the information answer?
- How do I use this information in my presentation – what format?
- Is this information persuasive and does it relate to my action item?
- Does this information generate new ideas or lead me to other sources?

5. Synthesize

- How can I logically organize my information?
- How can I make an outline of my research results?
- What type of format will I use to present my information?
- How can I put all of the information together to tell my story?

6. Evaluation

- Based on my research, did I answer all of my questions?
- Are my sources credible and reliable?
- Am I presenting my information in a clear and concise manner?
